## DO YOU KNOW WHAT'S **FALSE!**?

#### "CALLING MY TICKETS IN ON A Monday is good planning."

**FALSE** Mondays are the busiest day at 811. Avoid long hold times on the phone by submitting your ticket at **Indiana811.org**.

#### "I KNOW WHERE ALL THE UTILITIES Are on my property, so I don't Need to submit a ticket."

FALSE Regardless of whether you think you know where utilities are buried, state law requires you to submit a locate request. Sometimes erosion or grading can unintentionally shift utilities, so it's always important to submit a locate request.

#### "IF A GAS LINE IS CUT, I SHOULD TRY TO STOP THE LEAK."

FALSE Leave the area immediately and call 911, the gas company and 811.

"I'M ONLY DOING A SMALL PROJECT (I.E. INSTALLING A MAILBOX, PLANTING A SHRUB, ETC.) SO I DON'T NEED TO SUBMIT A TICKET."

FALSE State law requires that anytime you break ground you are required to submit a locate request.

### DO YOU KNOW WHAT'S **FALSE**?

### "EXCAVATOR TRAINING IS EXPENSIVE AND HARD TO SCHEDULE."

**FALSE** Contact Indiana 811 to schedule a free excavator training class that works with your schedule.

#### "THE GENERAL CONTRACTOR HAS A TICKET. I DON'T NEED ONE AS THE SUB-CONTRACTOR."

FALSE You cannot piggyback on someone else's ticket.

"INDIANA LAW SAYS THAT TICKETS MUST BE MARKED WITHIN 2 BUSINESS DAYS."

"INDIANA LAW SAYS LOCATE REQUESTS Are good for 20 days."



"YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR KEEPING YOUR TICKET VALID IF YOUR PROJECT LASTS LONGER THAN 20 DAYS."
